The emphasis is on taking part and the workshops will be led by skilled and enthusiastic Folk Campers attending for the week.

The Area and Points of Interest

In addition to Symonds Yat itself there are some wonderful walks along the Wye and in the Forest of Dean which is close by. Historic MONMOUTH is only 5 miles away and HEREFORD, HAY on WYE (famous for its bookshops) and ROSS on WYE are all worth taking a short journey to visit.

The Paddocks Hotel is set in the spectacular Symonds Yat Valley on the River Wye. The hotel has en-suite bedrooms and once all the hotel rooms have been booked we can also use some well equipped chalets in the grounds. Dogs are not permitted in the Hotel, only in the chalets - limited spaces available.

The enormous ballroom is used for music and dancing and also some of the crafts. The lounge will be used as the second craft space. The Hotel also has a dining room and two bars.
