

Summer family weeks (fully-catered)

LYMPSTONE, East Devon 21 July to 18 August (4 weeks)

The beautiful fishing village of Lympstone on the River Exe. Surrounded by open fields, our marquee site in Haresfield has views of the river estuary, and the sandy beaches of Exmouth are less than 4 miles away. Dartmoor and Exmoor are just a drive away.

COCKSHUTT, Shropshire 28 July to 4 August (1 week)

Based at the village hall it is said to be the quietest part of Shropshire. With a landscape of meres and mosses, full of wildlife (bring binoculars) and miles of languid canals weaving their way through unspoilt countryside, it also takes in the World Heritage Site at Pontcysyllte with the breath-taking aqueducts.

St DENIS Le GAST, NORMANDY, FRANCE 28 July to 11 August (2 weeks)

A return to this friendly village where in the past we have had music sessions in the bars of the village and an evening soirée at the hall where we have swapped English and French dances. Many things to see in the area including the D-Day Landing beaches, The Tapestry at Bayeux and Villedieu les Poêles with its famous bell foundry. There are some beautiful uncrowded sandy beaches at Les Salines near Bréhal.

Self-catering village hall weekends

WILDHERN, near Andover, Hampshire (long weekend) 4 to 7 May

The hamlet of Wildhern lies on the very fringe of the North Wessex Downs.

BECKFORD, Worcestershire (dancers' event - short weekend) 25 to 27 May

A weekend targeted at the more experienced dancer with a focus on challenging dances to quality music. The village of Beckford sits beneath Bredon Hill.

DALTON, North Yorkshire (long weekend) 1 to 5 June (Jubilee weekend)

Dalton village is less than 7 miles from the Yorkshire Dales National Park.

CHIDDINGLY, Sussex (long weekend) 1 to 5 June (Jubilee weekend)

Chiddingly is part of Wealden District Close to Beachy Head, the Seven Sisters and Cuckmere Haven and the Long Man of Wilmington together with various high points along the South Downs.

MISERDEN, Gloucestershire (session music event - short weekend) 15 to 17 June

A weekend to appeal to those musicians who like to get together and play by ear. Miserden is a small picturesque village near Gloucester.

BECKFORD, Worcestershire (musicians' event - short weekend) 22 to 24 June

A weekend for players of any kind of instrument. Lots of playing from music notation and a little bit of dancing. The village of Beckford sits beneath Bredon Hill.

WHIXLEY, North Yorkshire (singers' event - long weekend) 5 to 8 July

Lots of singing with just a smattering of music and dance. Whixley is a small village near Knaresborough.

KINGTON LANGLEY, Wiltshire (long weekend) 24 to 27 August

The small village of Kington Langley lies between the M4 to the north and Chippenham to the south. A comfortable village hall with showers and a large camping field.

WHIXLEY, North Yorkshire (long weekend) 24 to 27 August

The village of Whixley, is close to Knaresborough, Harrogate and York. A modernised village hall, enclosed camping site and a village pub make this one of the most popular events in our calendar.
