Folk Camps Dogs Policy

Dogs are allowed on most Folk Camps sites and dog owners are normally conversant with the common sense rules of looking after their animals. However some sites do not allow dogs at all.

The following rules for dogs should be noted and adhered to at all times.

1. They must be kept on a lead.
2. All exercising must be outside the camp site.
3. **They must NEVER be taken into the marquee / hall or the kitchen (guide dogs are excepted).**
4. Inadvertent messes must be cleared up by the owner immediately.
5. Dogs must be kept far away from the hall or marquee, the entrances to the hall or marquee, workshop areas and the washing up areas (guide dogs are excepted).
6. It is generally courteous for campers to keep their dogs close to their own tent or caravan and to ensure that they do not create a nuisance to their neighbours.
7. At some Folk Camps sites, the landowner may give instructions that ban the exercising of dogs in certain locations such as fields or woods used for breeding pheasants or sheep fields. These instructions must be followed. **Some farmers reserve the right to shoot dogs dead** that cause a nuisance on their farm land.

If any dog owner cannot control their dog and these rules are not followed then Folk Camps reserves the right to exclude the dog from the site and/or not accept further bookings with dogs from that dog owner.
